**Approval of Agenda**-By a motion of R.Rees, D.Good 2<sup>nd</sup> Ayes—4, Nays-0, Absent-1. Carried.

**Approval of Consent Agenda-Bills and Minutes from July 12, 2010 Meeting**- By a motion of D. Good, R. Rees 2<sup>nd</sup>. D.Good questioned a bill from Whaley Waste for a Dumpster for \$502.60 at 601 S.Walnut, Winfield, Iowa 52659. J. ## **Departmental Reports**

### **Public Works**

R.Rodgers reported he has received the leak survey back and did find some leaks but no major ones that would result from the water problem. He also reported of a leak on the east side of town that needs to be repaired. R.Rodgers also reported of painting lines and has been doing some seal coating. The water tower will be down for inspection on Wednesday night and will be filled on Thursday morning. There will be a boil order for the city until Saturday.

### **Library**

L.Hockenberry reported 2,770 for circulation, 1130 people from Winfield used the library. The book club will be meeting on the first Tuesday of the month. M.Thomas wrote a note thanking all the volunteers in the activities within the last month.

### **Police**

J.Dietrich was not present to give a report. J. Suter reported he talked to Officer Walter about the activity. Activity has been quiet up to the weekend for the Crooked Creek Days celebration.

### **Clerk**

S. Finnell reported she has completed her 3<sup>rd</sup> year of clerk school and has submitted her application as a CMC. She also reported of the League Conference September 22-24 in Coralville, will be doing software update next week and the ICAP- Loss Control review is on Tuesday Aug 10, 2010.

### **Public Forum**

Jan Walter asked about the progress of the Nichols property. J. Suter reported that the city is working on the situation and making sure that everything is being done correctly.
