Yard Waste:

- The City's compost pile is located on 130th Street (southeast edge of town, past the solar panels). Please watch for signs and proceed as directed.
- **Leaves** can be bagged and placed on the curb for Public Works department to pick-up during the regular working hours. Sticks can be piled next to bags for pick-up.
- If you burn leaves, they cannot be burnt a half an hour before sunrise and a half an hour after sunset. Any burning of yard waste MUST be attended by the resident at all times while the fire is burning. Burning leaves on the street is prohibited.

Snow Removal Guidelines

It is unlawful to park any vehicle on any public street in the city at the anytime within twelve (12) hours after a snowfall of three (3) inches or more unless the streets have been cleared. (Code of Iowa, 321.136[1])

If the vehicle is not moved, the owner may be fined and the vehicle can be towed at the owner's expense.

It is unlawful for any person to (or cause to) throw, push, or place snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the street or alley. Except where, in the cleaning of large commercial drives in the business district it is absolutely necessary to move the snow onto the street or alley temporarily by the owner or agent. Arrangements for prompt removal of such accumulations shall be made prior to moving the snow.

Sidewalks need to be cleaned of snow promptly- within ten (10) hours after a snowfall.
